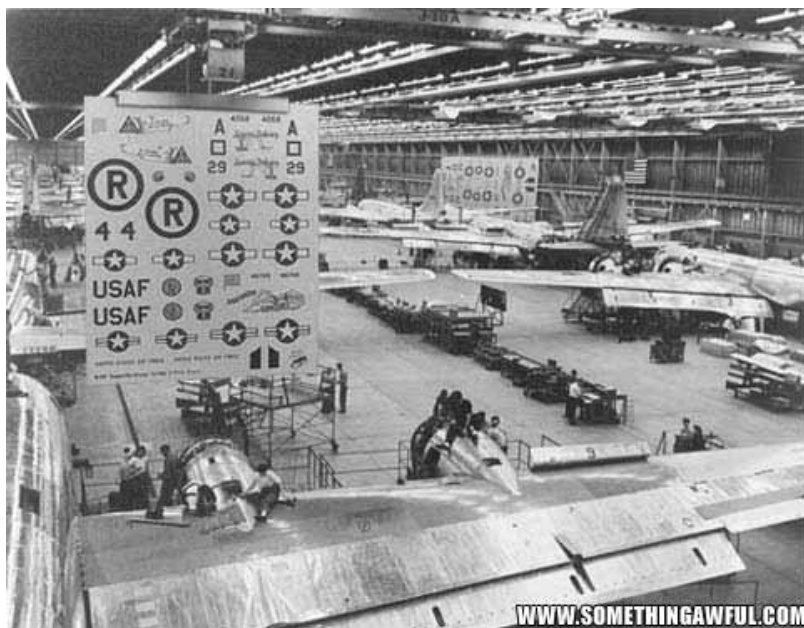

### **Code of Conduct for Shows**

- Do not spill any food or drinks on the tablecloths; if possible avoid eating or drinking behind the stand.
- Keep the language clean. Swear words may well put off families with children from approaching the club.
- Always keep the stand manned - with 1 person in front if possible. If you are the only person there and need to leave the stand find someone else from the club and request they take over.
- Be polite to the punters.
- If you see someone has been manning the stand for a long period of time - offer them a break.
- Be careful with the models - report any damage and arrange for repair if possible. Unless absolutely necessary let the owner of the model move it.
- When setting up - make sure that the club name placard is on show, that flyers are available and that themes are clearly identified.
- Try not to bring along the same models time after time. Refresh your display models as often as possible.

### **Club Sweatshirts**

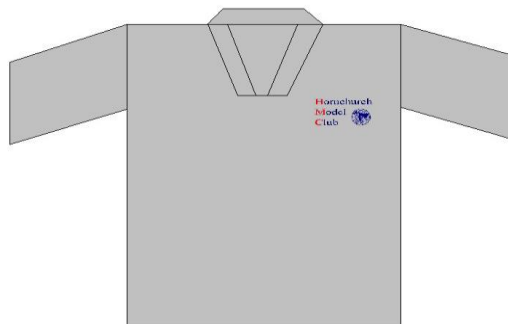

### ***Sunderland Found in Lake Windermere***

A salvage team have found a Sunderland flying boat at the bottom of Lake Windermere. It has long been rumoured that the aircraft was down there, having been sunk there at the end of World War Two.

Several weeks ago a salvage expert used side scan sonar to survey the northern end of the lake and reported seeing an aircraft's outline on the screen. The image appears to show the aircraft under an inch of mud in deep water close to White Cross Bay, and it appears to be intact.

The salvage team are hoping to raise enough money to perform further surveys and run a salvage operation this summer.

#### War and Peace Show

21 - 25 July

This year the largest military show in the world will be celebrating the 60th anniversary of D-day, special guest will be appearing and on the Friday forces sweetheart Dame Vera Lynn, their will be various arena events and battle scenes through each day. Admission on the day is £12 adults and £10 for children and senior citizens. Where? The Hop Farm Country Park Paddockwood, Kent via M23.

#### Military Odyssey

28th - 30 August

The world's largest multi period historical and living history show. Famous battle scenes from the English War of the Roses to the Second World War. 7500 fully equipped historically equipped personal will re-enact battles drills and in historic times plus traders etc. the show is held at the Kent county show ground, Detling, Kent

Battle of Britain MK1 Hurricane for sale, this Hurricane was one that last served in Russia and was one of four that was brought back to England and has been rebuilt by Hawker Restorations and is nearly ready to fly. This is the oldest MK1 only known and thought in the B.O.B any offers?

Over the winter period several warbirds have departed from Duxford, P-40 Kittyhawk and F4U Corsair of the Old Flying Machine Company to New Zealand and a MK14 Spitfire from the Fighter Collection to the USA, on the up side though a Fairey Gannet will be on the airshow circuit this year also about to take to the air is the latest Spitfire from Historical Flying at Duxford which has had its first engine test and will be flying soon also joining the Old Flying Machine Company is MK16 Spitfire from Halton which is to stay at Duxford for the coming season. The P-38 that was rumoured to be coming to Duxford has been sold on in USA, also returning to Duxford is Plane Sailings Catalina with the TR9 Spitfire at Duxford the number of air worthy Spits in Great Britain is now 20 with 18 under restoration or in museums plus 6 Hurricanes and 4 under restoration, also seven Mustangs with 3 under restoration. Next year will see the return of the mighty Vulcan to the airshow, now that it has got the £1 1/2 million from the Heritage Fund. Test flying should start later in the year if all goes well.
